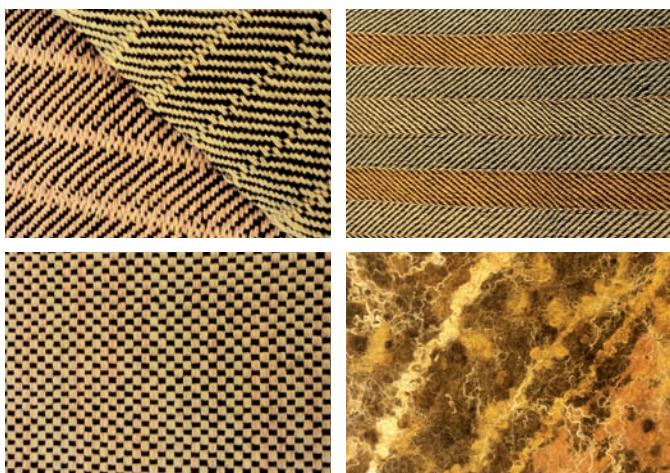
## LITMANS
